Things to See & Do in Garden Grove

1. Visit the Chamber of Commerce at 12866 Main Street to get a map of Garden Grove.
2. Buy a game of Garden Grove-opoly and try to buy all the properties in Garden Grove! Call (714) 741-5280 for information!
3. Take a drive down Garden Grove Boulevard, explore the Korean Business District, and discover a taste of Korean culture.
4. Make a wish and throw a coin in the Civic Center Library fountain at 11200 Stanford Avenue.
5. View artwork from students in the Garden Grove Unified School District on the first floor of City Hall, located at 11222 Acacia Parkway.
6. Nibble on French, Chinese and Vietnamese specialties in Little Saigon.
7. Slither down the dragon slide at Atlantis Play Center, adjacent to Garden Grove Park, 9301 Westminster Boulevard (Closed Mondays).
8. Check out the ever-changing, modern look of Harbor Boulevard from Chapman Avenue to Garden Grove Boulevard.
9. Crash a car show any Friday night on Main Street, between Garden Grove Boulevard and Acacia Parkway.
10. Find out about, and join the fun at, one of the four unique Garden Grove festivals: the Arab-American, Korean, Strawberry and Tet Festivals.
11. Bring the whole family to enjoy jazz, rock, pop and swing music during the Free Summer Concerts on Thursday nights. Call (714) 741-5280 for information.
12. Play tennis at Magnolia Park, 11402 Magnolia Street.
13. Take a tour of the Crystal Cathedral, 12141 Lewis Street, Monday through Saturday from 9:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.
14. Explore Garden Grove's first fire station and fire truck at the Stanley Ranch Museum, 12174 Euclid. While you are there, check out Walt Disney's first studio garage.
15. Hit a few golf balls at the only driving range in Garden Grove, Harbor Greens at 12261 Chapman Avenue.
16. Expand your mind by taking a class at one of the many schools in Garden Grove: Coastline Community College, Cal State Fullerton's Garden Grove campus, University of La Verne, and Concord Career Institute, all located at the corner of Euclid and Garden Grove Boulevard.
17. Visit the largest mosque west of the Mississippi at the Islamic Society of Orange County, 9752 West 13th Street.
18. Stop to contemplate in the California city with the most churches per capita. The city's oldest church, the United Methodist Church, is located at 13741 Main Street.
19. Be inspired; visit Memorial Plaza on Civic Center Drive between Euclid and Ninth Street.

20. Bike or hike the longest street in Garden Grove, Lampson Avenue from Manley to Lewis Street.
21. Explore the outdoors along the trail at Twin Lakes Park, 12952 Lampson Avenue.
22. Watch, or play, street hockey at the Chapman Sports Complex (corner of Chapman Avenue and Knott Street) or roller hockey at Pioneer Park, 12722 Chapman Avenue.
23. Get a bike license and fire safety tips any Saturday morning, at any fire station in Garden Grove, from 8:30 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. Call (714) 741-5624 for more information.
24. Stop by the Tower on the Green clock tower and share a picnic lunch on the grass at Village Green Park, 12732 Main Street.
25. Stop by the Grove Theater Center to watch a live performance at 12852 Main Street.
26. Examine the giant flea, fly, mosquito, tick, black widow, spider and scorpion displayed on the wall at Orange County Vector Control, 13001 Garden Grove Boulevard.
27. Visit the Anyang Sister City display to see pictures and cultural items from Anyang City, South Korea, located on the third floor of City Hall, 11222 Acacia Parkway.
28. On a hot summer day, take a dip in one of the public swimming pools located at Eastgate, Magnolia or Woodbury Parks.
29. Find out what's on stage at the Garden Grove Playhouse, 12001 St. Mark Street.
30. Play 18 holes of golf at the City-owned Willowick Municipal Golf Course at 3017 West 5th Street. Call (714) 554-0672 for a tee time.
31. Watch a movie at Regal Cinemas, 9741 Chapman Avenue, or Four Star Cinemas, 12111 Valley View Street.
32. Stop by the oldest family-owned market in Orange County, Zlaket's Market, 12921 Main Street, to pick up a sandwich, some groceries or fresh meat.
33. Enjoy food and fun at one of the many restaurants located at Harbor Boulevard and Chapman Avenue.
34. Watch the ducks, and trace America's achievements in space, at the Civic Center pond, 11200 Stanford Avenue.
35. Watch, or play, a game of soccer at the Arena Soccer Park, located at 9301 Westminster Avenue, in Garden Grove Park.
36. Reflect on the past, read the inscriptions at the "We the People" statue, at Harbor and Garden Grove Boulevards; and the "Union Passage" statue, in the Civic Center Park, 11200 Stanford Avenue.
